Determined Admissions Arrangements for Hartlip Endowed Church of England (Voluntary Aided) Primary School

Academic Year 2024-2025

Hartlip Endowed Church of England Primary School will be part of the KCC Co-ordinated Scheme for Entry to Year R in September 2024. *Year R applications are normally for children born between 1 September 2019 and 31 August 2020.*

For normal points of entry to school, Kent resident parents will have the opportunity to apply for their child's school place either online at www.kent.gov.uk/ola or by using a standard paper form known as the Reception Common Application Form (RCAF). Kent County Council cannot accept multiple applications for the same child. A parent may use either of the above methods, but not both. Kent County Council will take all reasonable steps to ensure that every parent resident in the Kent knows how to apply for a school place by completing a RCAF/JCAF online at www.kent.gov.uk/ola or on paper, and has access to a written explanation of the coordinated admissions scheme. Families with a Medway address will have the opportunity to name a Kent school on the Medway Council form at www.medway.gov.uk.

The application process for entry into the Reception Year in September 2024-25 begins in November 2023 until the close date of 15 January 2024. National Offer Day when parents are advised of the school allocated will be 16 April 2024.
